Why do I need different folds?

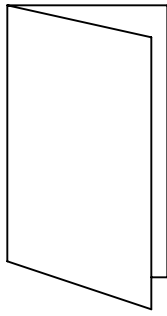
- Different folds offer a more professional approach to your design, this enables you to incorporate better designs and get a more unique product.

What is folding?

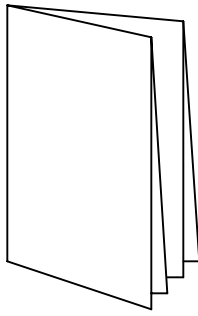
- Folding is the process of converting a printed sheet into a section or a final product by folding the paper using bukling or knife techniques. For example if a printed sheet with size 62x90 cm and your final job size is A4 size (29.7x21.0 cm) you need to transfer the 62x90 to 29.7x21. This is done by the folding machine.

What folds can IPH produce?

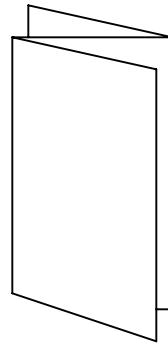
- Depending on page size, sheet size and language different folds can be produced.

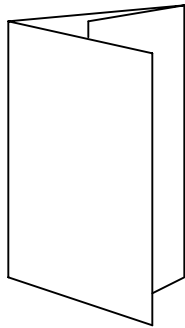

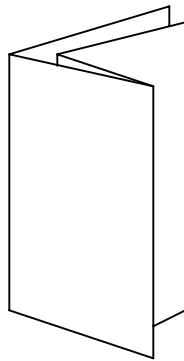
8 pp right-

French fold



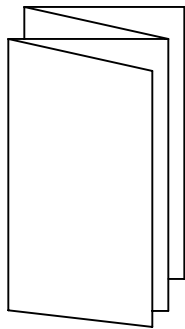
6 pp

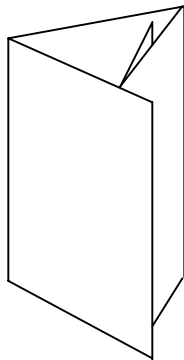

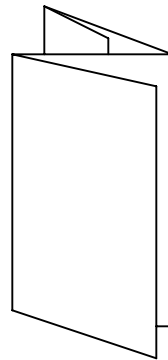
8 pp parallel
double fold



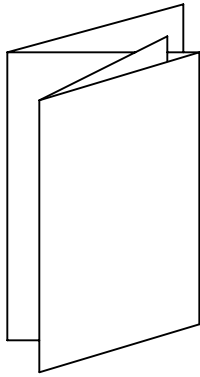

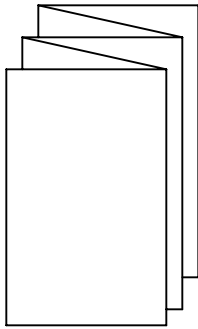
8pp Parallel

and outer fold



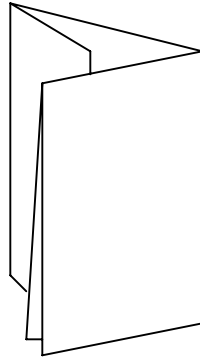
8 pp parallel
map fold



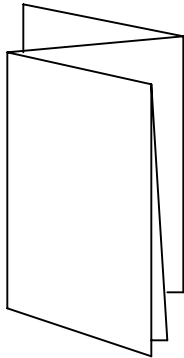
8 pp reverse
